Dear Sir

Genl Lee's Winder having mentioned to me that he understood you were in want of a Clerk, I respectfully ask for the position and would refer you to him as to my capabilities for the office. — I and brother & myself were compelled last May to leave Baltimore and since that time have been in the service of the Southern Confederacy as members of the 1st Md. Regt. I have just rec^d my discharge to enable me to seek some office for the support of my family who have just arrived in Richmond. — I have had a large experience as Clerk, having had charge of the Books of a large Mercantile House for six years. — The wants of my family only compels me to leave my Regiment where I have been for the past 6 months. —
