Private Ridgely Small, of Captain James R Herbert's Company, (G.) of the 1st Maryland Regiment of Confederate States, was enlisted by Capt James R Herbert, of the 1st Regiment of Maryland Co., at Harper's Ferry on the 1st day of June 1861, to serve for two years; he was born in Baltimore in the State of Maryland, is Twenty Six years of age, Five feet, Seven inches high, Dark complexion, Dark Blue eyes, Brown hair, and by occupation when enlisted a Merchant. During the last two months said soldier has been unfit for duty sixty days. *(Here consult directions on Form Med. Dept. Gen. Reg.)*
