CERTIFICATE OF DISABILITY FOR DISCHARGE.

(To be used, in duplicate, in all cases of discharge on account of disability.)

William D. Conn, of Captain *Herbert's*
 Company, (D,) of the *1st Maryland* Regiment of Confederate States
 was enlisted by *Captain Herbert*, of
 the *first* Regiment of *Maryland Vol.*, at *Harpers-ferry*
 on the *twenty second* day of *May*, 1861, to serve *one* year; he was born
 in *Baltimore* in the State of *Maryland*, is *thirty five*
 years of age, *five* feet *six* inches high, *fair* complexion, *grey* eyes,
light hair, and by occupation when enlisted a *Lawyer*. During the last two
 months said soldier has been unfit for duty *56* days. (Here consult directions on Form 1124, p. 285, and directions on Form 12, p. 209, Med. Dept. Gen. Reg.)

Said soldier, though appearing well and willing to perform his duties, is subject to attacks of Mania for which he has been frequently treated in the Hospitals of Maryland, and, in my opinion, is unfit for duty.
